Goat Classes/Milking Competitions are held under the Rules, Regulations and Recognition of the British Goat Society. All Exhibits must be registered with the BGS as in the ownership and in the name of exhibitor, the registered name and number being quoted on the Entry Form (also the kidding date for goats in milk). All goats in milk must be kidded or aborted a minimum of 30 days previous to the date of the show. All milking goats must be on the Show ground by 5pm on Friday 16th July, to be stripped out under an appointed steward by 6.30pm. No milking machines allowed.

CHAMPION PRIZE

THE CHESTER CUP for the Best Exhibit in the Goat Section

£50 is awarded to goat from classes 304, 305 that has highest yield on the day.

AWARDS

Rosettes are awarded to the Best Goatling, Reserve Goatling, Best Kid and Reserve Kid.
